Height: 39 Storeys

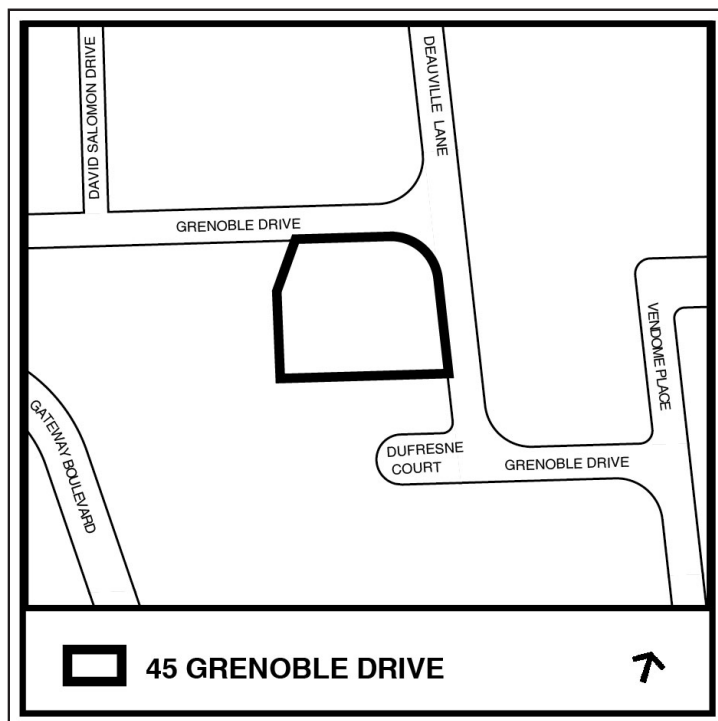
Number of Dwelling Units: 405
